

Care Instructions

ANILINE LEATHERS:

- Full grain aniline leather is the purest and most natural looking leather and most sought-after look. This leather will age over time and change colour due to weather conditions, the natural oil in your skin, external condition and general wear-and-tear. Showing the true character of aniline leather over time.
- Scratches, marks, and flaws are not considered to be defects but rather a stamp of authenticity.
- Aniline leather is not dirt resistant and should be treated with love & care. Excessive rubbing on rough surfaces will damages and buff the leather.
- Rub off dirt or fluids on your handbag immediately with a warm damp cloth. Blot off extra moisture with a clean dry cloth. DO NOT let your handbag dry in the sun. Let your handbags fully dry and treat with balsam. DO NOT rub the leather but rather blot it.
- Severe dirt can be blotted with a damp cloth and a small amount of non-acidic soap. Blot excess soap of with a damp cloth. DO NOT rub.
- Treat handbags with leather balsam monthly and let it dry for 24hours. Add more balsam if leather looks tired and worn. Leather balsam will restore the natural look of the leather.

- Sheduli range in the following colour options: Desert, Tan, Grey, Cigar & Olive

ANILINE LEATHERS WITH PULL UP FINISH:

- Full grain aniline leather is the purest and most natural looking leather and most sought-after look. This leather will age over time and change colour due to weather conditions, the natural oil in your skin, external condition & general wear-and-tear. Showing the true character of aniline leather over time. Pull up leather refers to a finish where oil is added to the leather to make it more supple, stretchy and self-healing. Self-healing leather will restore everyday marks and soft bumps on the surface of the item.
- Scratches, marks, and flaws are not considered to be defects but rather a stamp of authenticity.
- Aniline leather is not dirt resistant and should be treated with love & care. Excessive rubbing on rough surfaces will damages and buff the leather.
- Rub off dirt or fluids on your handbag immediately with a warm damp cloth. Blot off extra moisture with a clean dry cloth. DO NOT let your handbag dry in the sun. Let your handbags fully dry and treat with balsam. DO NOT rub the leather but rather blot it.
- Severe dirt can be blotted with a damp cloth and a small amount of non-acidic soap. Blot excess soap of with a damp cloth. DO NOT rub.

• Treat handbags with leather balsam monthly to help your self-healing leather to do its job and let it dry for 24hours. Add more balsam if leather looks tired and worn. Leather balsam will restore the natural look of the leather.

ANILINE LEATHERS WITH ZAMBEZI BUF FINISH:

- Full grain aniline leather is the purest and most natural looking leather and most sought-after look. This leather will age over time and change colour due to weather conditions, the natural oil in your skin and external condition. Showing the true character of aniline leather over time. Zambezi buffed leather refers to a finish where the leather is buffed off to give it that multi-dimensional and organic look. Buffed leather should be treated as a suede.
- Scratches, marks, and flaws are not considered to be defects but rather a stamp of authenticity.
- Aniline leather is not dirt resistant and should be treated with care and attention. Excessive rubbing on rough surfaces will damages and buff the leather. For best result treat buffed leather with a leather sealant for ultimate results.
- Rub of dirt or fluids on your handbag immediately with a warm damp cloth. Blot off extra moisture with a clean dry cloth. DO NOT let your handbag dry in the sun. Let your handbags dry on the spot and treat with balsam. DO NOT rub the leather but rather blot it.
- Severe dirt can be blotted with a damp cloth and a small amount of non-acidic soap. Blot excess soap of with a damp cloth. DO NOT rub.
- Do not use leather balsam on buffed leathers.

Buffed range in the following colour options: Butterscotch, Grey, Whiskey & Brown

SEMI-ANILINE LEATHERS:

- Full grain semi-aniline leathers have the benefit of a thin polymer finishing layer on the surface of the leather making it more durable. Semi-aniline leather shows less scratches, marks, and flaws. But if you see some imperfections please note that they are not considered to be defects but rather a stamp of authenticity.
- Semi-aniline leather is more colourfast and less likely to fade. It has the benefits of a protective surface finish with the increased wearability.
- Excessive rubbing on rough surfaces will damages and buff the leather.
- Rub of dirt or fluids on your handbag immediately with a warm damp cloth. Blot off extra moisture with a clean dry cloth. DO NOT let your handbag dry in the sun. Let your handbags dry on the spot and treat with balsam. DO NOT rub the leather but rather blot it.
- Severe dirt can be blotted with a damp cloth and a small amount of non-acidic soap. Blot excess soap of with a damp cloth. DO NOT rub.
- Rub handbags with leather balsam every 3-6 months and let it dry for 24hours. Add more balsam if leather looks tired and worn. Leather balsam will restore the natural look of the leather.
